- If you did not make the priority list, do not contact the CTO or NP&E organization. Please contact d2@attsuppliers.com from SCTT team. They will evaluate your pitch/proposals and connect you with CTO if needed or keep you in our database and contact you if the need arises
- To submit POC's, evaluations or Lab trials to AT&T, please contact d2@attsuppliers.com.
